



Notice Regarding Fraudulent Job Offer Letters

It has recently come to our attention that unauthorized individuals have been sending out fake employment offers by sending letters attached hereto by fax or e-mail using the Blue Energy Co. Ltd. ("Blue Energy") service mark, company name and addresses, director names and logos in an attempt to defraud to you. Many fraudulent letters have been sent from following addresses; inquiring@blue-energy.net, inforblue.energy@gmail.com, or kenjikohno@blue-energy.net.

Blue Energy and its affiliated companies do not offer employments by sending fax or e-mail to you. Therefore, if any person sent you fax or e-mail offering employment with a job offer letter, a contract document, or any other documents, you should assume that the communication is not from Blue Energy and its affiliated companies or any firm working on behalf of Blue Energy.

Please DO NOT respond to the fraudulent letter. If you receive any communication purportedly from Blue Energy; or if there is any doubt as to the authenticity of any communication from or about Blue Energy, please report it to Blue Energy via e-mail immediately contact to us.
